

Special Meeting
Mayor and Council
December 11, 2014

A Special Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Allendale, was held in the Municipal Building at 500 West Crescent Avenue, Allendale, NJ on December 11, 2014. The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Mayor Barra who announced that the requirements of the Open Public Meetings Act were met by the required posting and notices to publications.

Public Comments:

There were no public comments.

Councilwoman White made a motion to go into executive session for contract negotiations with the APBA, seconded by Councilman Bernstein.

Frank Valenzuela, Acting Borough Clerk, read the Sunshine Law Statement regarding closed sessions for Collective Bargaining.



There was a general discussion about various items that were presented for consideration. The APBA and the Mayor and Council broke into separate discussion groups to consider offers made by both parties. Indications were that progress was being made. The APBA will bring the proposals back to the union and the rank and file.

Councilwoman White made a motion to adjourn the Special Meeting at 7:15; seconded by Councilman Bernstein. Vote was unanimous in favor.
