HEALTH OFFICER/SANITARY REPORTS

-117 Franklin Turnpike - residents appeared in Court. Another summons was issued right before Court because Carol from Tyco saw that they were continuing to feed the cats. The prosecutor sat with them and explained, once again, that they cannot do this and that they will go to trial and be given high fines. It was also noted that their house has been cleaned up and a lot of work has been completed both inside and out.

-Board of Health received complaints about Village Pizza. A reinspection was performed and they are much improved.

-Inspected Brookside School and Northern Highlands. Both were satisfactory.

-Nosher-Rye has opened and so has Peanut Butter Blues Café.

-Inspected Allendale Bar and Grill's grease trap with John Wittekind. He believes one of the sinks in the kitchen was draining into the sump pump in the basement instead of into the grease trap. He asked them to have it repaired to see if that corrects the problem. The situation will be monitored the plumbing inspector, John Wittekind.

-Blimpie's, Allendale Eats and Bernie's Bagels food samples were all satisfactory.

-Performed a Chapter 24 at Savini's and were found to be satisfactory.

-Inspected Allendale Nursing Home and Carlton Court. Found them heating red tomato sauce (with no meat in it) on the steam table. Food taken from the refrigerator must go on the stove or into the oven, not heated on a steam table. The other foods on the table were hot and had correct temperatures. Upon reinspection, they were fine.

-An Allendale resident had a new chimney flue installed. A fire was made and they did not close the flue which resulted in a squirrel entering the fireplace. Animal Control was called and removed it.

OLD/NEW BUSINESS

-Robin Iversen and Christopher Martin have agreed to serve another three year term as Board of Health members. The Oath of Office was given and signed.
