JUNE

- Received calls regarding renovations at Allendale Bar & Grill. Visited site and explained that no work can be done in the kitchen until plans are approved by building department and health department.
- Complaint received re Acme Supermarket. Investigated same and spoke with manager re handwashing and glove use between tasks. Upon reinspection found them satisfactory. Complaint abated.
- Acme Sushi – Performed Chapter 24, Risk 4, inspection and they were satisfactory.
- Inspected food vendors at the Guardian Angel Church Carnival, and were satisfactory.
- Complaint received re stagnant water behind shopping mall. Photos taken and forwarded same to the management company. Problem was abated.
- Crestwood Lake and The Whitney Pool results were compliant.
- 117 Franklin Turnpike – released dog from ten day confinement.
- Inspected The Gifted Child Society, Summer Super Stars Youth Camp, and they were compliant.

JULY

- Allendale Bar & Grill, performed a Chapter 24, plan review and were approved.
- Holiday Observers 4th of July event inspected same and were satisfactory.

-Northern Highlands hosted a temporary food event and posted satisfactory.

-Masa Sushi & Grill – Chapter 24 Risk 4 – had multiple handwashing violations and were posted conditional.

-Met with DPW and reviewed what needs to be tested at Crestwood Lake if new company is chosen to do water testing.

-Two bat incidents -

-59 W. Maple Ave - One bat in home with family dog who is current with rabies shots and recommended that he be given a booster. Will do follow up once results from testing the bat are received. In the meantime, we emailed information on rabies and bats to resident.

-Thereafter confirmation was later received that the bat at the above residence tested negative.

-303 E. Allendale Ave -Consulted with Tyco. Bat was not sent for testing since resident previously received rabies vaccinations and chose not to. No children or animals were in the home.
