Minutes of the Board of Health

June 1, 2017

ROLL CALL: A regular meeting of the Allendale Board of Health was held in the Municipal Building on the above date. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by Christopher Martin.

The following members were present. Linda Morgan, Susan Toron, Robin Iversen, Maria Crean and Christopher Martin. Nadine Benoit and Bruce Beck were absent.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

The May 2017 Minutes were accepted with a motion to approve by Maria Crean and seconded by Linda Morgan.

SECRETARY/REGISTRAR'S REPORT

Adult Health Clinic – No Adult Health Clinic was held.

Child Health Clinic – No children attended the Child Health Clinic.

Vital Statistics – 4 Deaths, 3 Births, 0 Marriages.

Receipts - \$28.00 in Marriage Licenses, \$20.00 in Certified Copies, \$250.00 in miscellaneous, totaling \$298.00.

COMMUNICATIONS/CORRESPONDENCE

-No correspondence was received.

HEALTH OFFICER/SANITARY REPORTS

-Crestwood Lake and The Whitney Pool opened Memorial Day weekend after receiving satisfactory inspection reports and lab results. An inspection of the concession stand at the lake was performed and was satisfactory as well.

-The Ambulance Corps held a special event called "Public Safety Day" on May 20, 2017. Hot dogs were being served and an inspection of the facility was performed by our sanitarian.

-We had an emergency inspection involving a sewage backup at Allendale Eats. Once it was cleared, the street and floors were cleaned and sanitized. They reopened within a few hours.

-A cat bite was reported. Same was investigated and the cat was observed and confined. The County nurse was notified for follow-up.

-A second animal bite was reported, dog to human. The pet was observed and confined and thereafter released.

-Performed a Chapter 24 at The Atrium and they posted satisfactory.

-Re the Privacy Act, we are awaiting direction from the Borough Attorney. It was agreed that the Police, Fire, and Ambulance departments will be notified of any health concerns.

-Regarding camp licensing, there are two summer camps in Allendale, however, no funds are being collected from them even though they are inspected. However, we have submitted our invoice to the YWCA for reimbursement for their after school programs which are held at Hillside and Brookside schools.

-Received a complaint for Bernie's Bagels. Performed a Chapter 24 and they were satisfactory.

-Complaint received regarding barking dogs on Hillside Avenue. Allendale's Ordinance entitled "Peace and Good Order" prohibits any dog or other animal to make such noise as to annoy or disturb the quiet, comfort or repose of persons in any dwelling or other type of residence or in the vicinity. The complainant was advised to call the police to witness the barking while it is occurring which would enable them to give a verbal warning. If that does not remedy the situation, a summons can be issued.

-Board of Health's Financial Disclosure statements have been completed.

-The Board of Health members will be available if needed during July and August.
