
Resolution 15-119

**BOROUGH OF ALLENDALE

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND, SUPPLEMENT AND REVISE
THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ALLENDALE,
PROPERTY MAINTENANCE, CHAPTER 199-12(N)**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Allendale, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey that Chapter 199-12 (N) of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Allendale, be amended and revised to read and provide as follows:

All fire hydrants shall have a minimum of a three-foot radius clearance from any plantings, snow, mailboxes and fencing, and there shall be no obstructions from the front of the hydrant to the street or right-of-way. Such clearance of snow must be accomplished within 24 hours of daylight after the snow shall have fallen.
