WHEREAS, the Borough of Allendale ("Allendale") by adoption of Chapter 53 of the Borough Code, and more particularly, Sections 53-11 through 53-14, have complied with the statutory mandate; and

WHEREAS, there currently exists a vacancy in the position of Municipal Engineer; and

WHEREAS, Allendale, on an interim basis, wishes to engage Michael Vreeland of the firm of Guerin & Vreeland Engineering, Inc., to perform engineer services for Allendale on the terms and conditions recited herein; and

WHEREAS, Michael Vreeland of the firm of Guerin & Vreeland Engineering, Inc. has agreed to provide such services; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Allendale, as follows:

1. Michael Vreeland of the firm of Guerin & Vreeland Engineering, Inc. is hereby designated and appointed, on an interim basis, to provide such engineering services to the Borough of Allendale as are more specifically contemplated by Section 53-13 of the Borough Code of the Borough of Allendale.

2. Those services rendered by Michael Vreeland and/or any engineer employed by the firm of Guerin & Vreeland Engineering, Inc. shall be billed at those rates specified in the Agreement for Engineering Services entered into between the parties and incorporated by reference hererin, and as otherwise provided for in the Annual Salary Ordinance of the Borough of Allendale.




WHEREAS, there presently is a vacancy in the Borough of Allendale ("Allendale") "in a position in which the duties of principal Public Works Manager"; and


WHEREAS, there presently exists a vacancy in the position of Director of Operations; and

WHEREAS, Allendale, by adoption of this Resolution wishes to appoint Ronald Kistner to the position of Director of Operations; and




Introduction of Ordinance #15-2
