

Ordinance 11-08
Borough of Allendale

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT
CHAPTER 256 OF THE CODE "VISUAL OBSTRUCTIONS"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Allendale, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey that Chapter 256 of the Code VISUAL OBSTRUCTIONS is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

Section I

The designation of Superintendent of Public Works referred to in 256-2, 3 and 4 is hereby deleted and in lieu thereof Property Maintenance Officer shall be applicable.

Section II

Repealer

All other provisions of this chapter which are not affected by this amendatory Ordinance are hereby ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect. However, all ordinances or parts of ordinances, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this amendatory Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section III

Severability

If any portion of this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance, but shall be confined in its effect to the provision directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

Section IV

Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as required by law.



Ordinance 11-10
Borough of Allendale

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 252
OF THE CODE ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Allendale, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey that Chapter 252 of the Code is amended and supplemented as follows:

Section I – 252-61 PARKING AREAS DEFINED.

- A. No change.
- B. East Side Parking Area. The East Side Parking Area shall be that area on the east side of the railroad tracks as designated on a map filed with the Borough Clerk entitled, "East Side Commuter and Shopper Parking Area, Borough of Allendale, Bergen County, NJ", prepared by Dewberry-Goodkind, Inc., dated July 26, 2011.

Section II – 252-62 PARKING PERMITS; RESIDENTS AND NONRESIDENTS;
SHOPPER PARKING; PARKING METERS.

A. Annual parking permits shall be issued by the Police Department for commuter parking in areas designated in the West Side Parking Area and East Side Parking Area. The Mayor, Council and Administrative Officer are empowered to establish rules and regulations for the sale and implementation of parking permits. Such rules and regulations shall be on file for public inspection at the office of the Borough Clerk. The hours of operation for the commuter parking shall be 6:00 a.m. prevailing time to 6:00 p.m. prevailing time. The fee for said permits shall be established by resolution of the Borough Council and shall renew in June of each year.

(1) There are hereby established resident parking spaces for the entire West Side Parking Area and 52 spaces in the East Side Parking Area. These resident parking spaces are for bona fide residents of the Borough of Allendale who have established proof of said residency.

(2) There are hereby established general parking spaces in the East Side Parking Area for commuters of the railroad who are and are not residents of the Borough of Allendale.

B. Shopper parking is hereby established in the Park and Ride facility as follows:

(1) Thirty Four shopper parking spaces are established in the East Side Parking Area for shoppers in the business district. A two-hour time limit is hereby established. Said spaces are outlined on the map on file with the Borough Clerk.

(2) All commuter parking permit spaces as outlined in Subsection A(2) above shall be shopper parking spaces from 6:00 p.m. prevailing time to 1:00 a.m. prevailing time, Monday through Friday, Saturday, Sunday and holidays from 6:00 a.m. prevailing time to 1:00 a.m. prevailing time.

C. Meter parking is hereby established in the Park and Ride facility as follows:

(1) Twelve meter spaces are established in the East Side Parking Area for daily commuters. No permit is required to park at these meters. The parking fee shall be established by resolution of the Borough Council. Meters shall operate from 6:00 a.m. prevailing time to 6:00 p.m. prevailing time, Monday through Friday inclusive.

Section II. Repealer

All other provisions of this chapter which are not affected by this amendatory Ordinance are hereby ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect. However, all ordinances or parts of ordinances, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this amendatory Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section III. Severability

If any portion of this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance, but shall be confined in its effect to the provision directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

Section IV. Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication provided by law; provided, however, that a violation of this Ordinance shall not be enforced until October 1, 2011.

Whereas, quotations were sought for 17 locations on the condition that the Borough reserved the right to increase, decrease or remove any of the locations set forth therein;


Whereas, the Borough has a funding limitation of \$15,000 in the current capital budget to use for the work;




