Minutes of the Board of Health

October 4, 2018

ROLL CALL: A regular meeting of the Allendale Board of Health was held in the Municipal Building on the above date. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by Linda Morgan.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

SECRETARY/REGISTRAR'S REPORT

Adult Health Clinic -held on 10/07/2018 – no one attended.

Child Health Clinic – No children attended.

HEALTH OFFICER/SANITARY REPORTS

- Acme Supermarket – complaint that they were using shopper's food carts for garbage collection throughout the store. To remedy this situation, they will paint certain food carts that will only be used for trash collection.

-We began our sight inspections and found Masa Sushi conditional again. When we entered, their handwash sink was blocked. Raw chicken and raw beef was being stored improperly. These are repeat violations. Once again I spoke to the manager and told him he must get a worker certified in each of these areas which would enable them to operate the kitchen properly.

-Rohsler's will be doing their October weekend BBQs and will be serving hot dogs, hamburgers etc. Our sanitarian went there to do a pre-operational inspection and they were satisfactory. She will stop by again one of these weekends to make sure they continue doing everything properly.

-Dog bite – A resident was fostering a dog. It is currently being confined for ten days at Rbari in Oakland. It was observed and was released.

OLD/NEW BUSINESS

-Sign up sheets for the Senior Flu Clinic and Free Rabies Clinic were presented. Five vials (50 shots) of Flu vaccine and eight vials (80 shots) of rabies vaccine were ordered.
