**HEALTH OFFICER/SANITARY REPORTS**

-Masa Sushi is conditional. There were handwashing issues, bare hand contact, sanitization issues. Summonses were issued and we will be going to Court at the end of the month.

-Crestwood Lake and The Whitney Pool. Had to do follow-up on both because of new pool code regulations. Upon reinspection, everything was satisfactory and they were approved to open.

-Reinspected Village Pizza and they posted satisfactory.

-Inspected Allendale Bar and Grill and they were satisfactory.

-Savini's Restaurant was conditional. They had cross contamination issues in their walk-in refrigerator and prep area. Raw meat was placed over lettuce and shell fish tags were not kept with the fish. If anyone was sick from the shellfish, it would be unable to trace.

-Performed Risk 2 at Starbucks and they were satisfactory.

-Inspected Allendale Steakhouse and they were satisfactory.

-Bernie's Bagels – Follow-up- re Food Manager's class to see if they attended and if an exam was taken.

-Restaurant L is conditional. Observed improper handwashing procedures, improper storage of rice. Cooking utensils stored in stagnant water. Shellfish tags were removed.

-Masa Sushi & Grill – Follow-up: Pest control company serviced the establishment and the dishwasher is now functioning properly.

-7 Carteret Court – Complaint received, investigated abandoned pool which is uncovered with standing water and subject to mosquito breeding – forwarded complaint to Mosquito Control.

-684 W. Crescent Avenue, dog was outside with racoon, racoon was sent for testing, informed resident racoon was negative for rabies.

-The County offers food handler and food manager courses in many languages so there is no reason for any restaurant employer/employee not to take them.

-An Allendale woman was walking a dog and both were bitten by a ground hog. A phone call was made to her and material on rabies was sent to the resident. She received a tetnus shot at Valley Hospital and was put on an antibiotic. She chose not to get the rabies shots.

-A resident came in to say she noticed a bird flying around in Masa Sushi after hours. Tyco was called in to remove the bird. Thereafter, our sanitarian went over to inspect their establishment.

#### **OLD/NEW BUSINESS**

-Goldberg's Bagels will be opening where Nostrama was. Our sanitarian will inspect the plans for this new establishment once they are forthcoming.

#### **PRESIDENT'S REPORT**


