NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough of Allendale, in the County of Bergen, as follows:

1. The fee to be charged by the Borough of Allendale for any special event food permit applied for in connection with Festival Day to be held on or about October 2019 shall be \$10, rather than \$50 as provided for in Section 210-2 of the Code; and
2. Except as set forth in Paragraph 1 hereinabove, the fee for a special event food permit shall be \$50 as provided for in Section 210-2 of the Code.
