Minutes of the Board of Health

January 2, 2020

ROLL CALL: A regular meeting of the Allendale Board of Health was held in the Municipal Building on the above date. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by Nadine Benoit.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

SECRETARY/REGISTRAR'S REPORT

Adult Health Clinic – No adult residents attended.

Kristen reported that all Retail Food inspections for the year 2019 were completed.

-Allendale Bar & Grill was conditional. Sinks were missing and insect activity was found. Reinspected and deemed satisfactory upon return.

-Walgreens had a complaint about their garbage. When inspected nothing was seen, the issued was dissolved.

-Dog bite – Dog bit the owner and the dog was confined.

-Aunt Deli's closed without notification. No inspection was done. Kristin has reached out to the owner and has not received a response. We encourage the public to be diligent and notify the Health Department if anyone sees activity in the store.

OLD/NEW BUSINESS

-Suez water held an information session at Town Hall. It was reported to Nadine that it was informative and everything seems to be under control. Nadine reached out to Amy and Ari to keep lines of communication with the Borough, Council and Suez open. This would allow for the Board of Health to receive information pertaining to any water issues smoothly and without interruption.

-USR/Allendale Coalition received a grant for 5 years of approx. \$600,000 for outreach programs in our schools (Allendale, USR, Saddle River) on drug awareness and any other issues that affect teens and our middle schools. There are monthly meetings and representatives from each town will attend. Robin volunteered to attend in Heidi's absence. Attendees will update the Board.

-The Oath of Office was given to Robin Iversen, Christopher Martin and Linda Morgan who were reappointed to the Board of Health and have agreed to serve another three-year term. We thank them for their service.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT


