

Dear Crestwood Lake Members,

The Borough and Lake Director, Tom Viscardi have been working hard in collaboration with local health officials to determine if we can logistically practice social distancing and open Crestwood Lake for members to enjoy. **We are happy to say that we have a plan and the opening date for Crestwood lake is on target for June 20th.** This will take cooperation, assistance and patience of all the members as we navigate the unknown new normal and ever-changing regulations.

We will be in constant communication and fully transparent as to what the new guidelines are for Crestwood to be in compliance with the Governor's Executive orders. If we all work together, we will make this work! Please be aware that the guidelines may change with short notice and know that we are committed to keep everyone informed. We are also always open to suggestions and constructive ideas!

Please carefully review the 2020 social distancing guidelines below:

Registration and Hours of Operation:

- The lake will be open from 11 am-7 pm throughout the season
- Registration is open
- There are no refunds unless we are ordered to shut down by the State
- Allendale lake Members are allowed to sponsor up to 2 families as usual
- Guest be will be allowed at the lake with lake member only. Single day guest passes can be purchased at the lake only with credit card as there will be no cash exchanged at the lake. Management reserved the right to limit guests if necessary during lake hours. There will be no guest books this year.
- There will be no badges or pictures taken. As you enter the lake the gate person will take your name to confirm registration

Social Distancing Guidelines

Beach & Water

- We will be opening all 3 beaches: **East** (main beach by concession), **South** (beach closest to Kunisch field) and **West** (beach across the lake as you walk in). We have figured out distancing calculations and maximum families allowed per beach. **Each family will have a 12 x 12 space with 9 extra feet around them for social distancing and walking.** There will be stakes to illustrate this on the beach. We will also have a social distancing ambassador to assist and ensure safety guidelines for members.
- We ask you **wear masks when walking around the beach & in the bathroom but not in the water.**
- Extra guards will be floating mid lake
- The slides and boards will initially be closed . Playground area remains closed.
- We ask you to please do not bring beach toys as per Executive Order 143

Bathrooms & Concession

- We will have a bathroom monitor to allow 1 person at a time. Rules will be posted upon entering:
 - Use sanitizer before entering (provided)
 - Wear masks
 - Wash hands before leaving rest room. There will be no paper towels or blower- so air dry!
- Bathrooms will be cleaned hourly with disinfectant
- Concession will be open with limited food and will be operating out of the back of the building
- Pete & Mary's Concession will be setting up family accounts so no cash is exchanged. Please email labarbiera@optonline.net to set this up.

Other IMPORTANT Info

- All the garbage receptacles will be removed. Everything you bring in YOU MUST BRING OUT. If takeout is ordered like pizza, the packaging MUST GO HOME WITH YOU. Please keep our lake beautiful, pick up after yourselves and do not leave any garbage at the lake! As always, please do not bring any GLASS to the lake
- Minor first Aid issues such as scrapes and cuts and bee stings will need to be handled by the parents. So please bring some band aids if your child is accident prone! 😊
- Management reserves the right to limit people, guests or change any of the guidelines as it deems appropriate for the safety and benefit of all members.
- There will be no camps this year and no beach rentals for parties including the red barn

We are happy to be able to offer beautiful Crestwood Lake this summer so people can get out, get your feet in the sand and take a nice swim. Let's be sure to continue to be patient, kind and understanding to your friends, family and neighbors.
